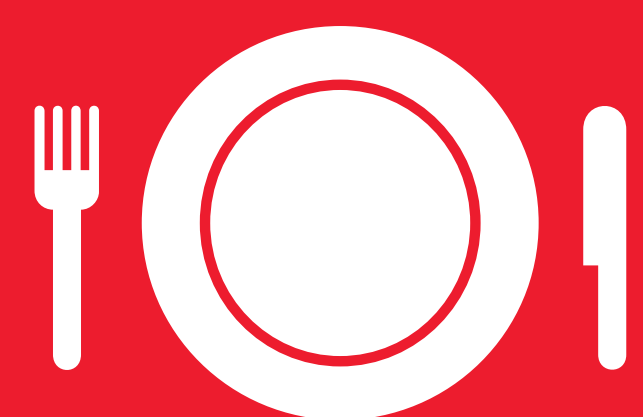
Walk & Roll

PLAY BY THE RULES



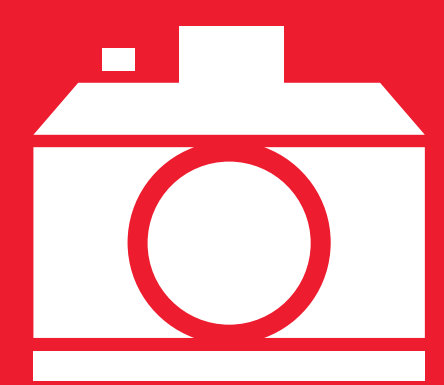
Keep Your Distance

Feel free to look, **but please do not touch the art!** Works of art are fragile, so keep a safe distance (*three feet is great*).



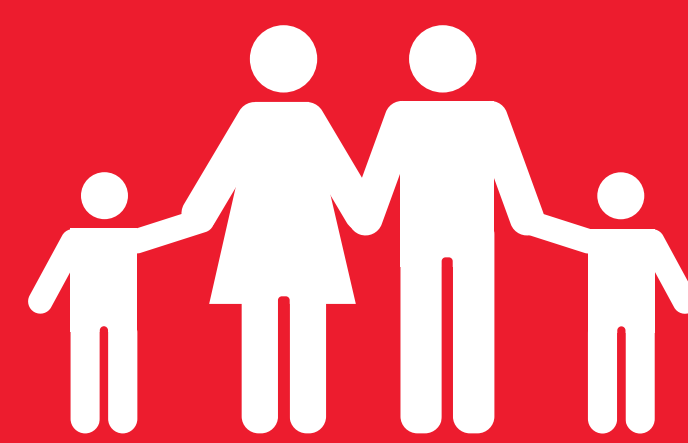
Lighten Up!

Please **check backpacks and umbrellas** at the **Coat Check**. *Front baby carriers and shoulder diaper bags are allowed in the galleries.*



Strike a Pose

Photography without a flash is allowed in the galleries unless otherwise indicated. To protect the artwork, **monopods and tripods are not allowed.**



Got Kids?

All children 12 and under must be supervised by an adult caregiver at all times. We recommend holding hands in the galleries with the youngest and fastest children.
